

Minnesota has been approved to implement an option called E SNAP that will issue extra SNAP benefits to some households who are already receiving SNAP. For households who are not receiving the maximum monthly allotment, DHS will issue a supplement to bring them up to the maximum allotment for their household size. This supplement will be for households who received benefits in March and April. Supplements for March recipients will be issued between April 27th and May 1st. Supplements for April recipients will be issued between May 18th and May 22nd.

If you received SNAP in March or April and your benefit was less than the maximum for your household you do not need to do anything to receive these extra benefits. These benefits will be issued directly from the state DHS office. If you are eligible you will be receiving a memo in the mail telling you about the extra issuance.
